

Report For Quedgeley Parish Council, 18th May 2009.

Figures for this report have been taken from Police Management Information System (MIS).

They are accurate as of Monday 18th May 2009, 1900hrs.

March 2009 had 57 calls to police relating to disorder.

Over the course of April 2009, police were called to record disorder 53 times, 25 of which were in the Kingsway estate.

March had 57 crimes, 15 of which were in the Kingsway estate.

During April 2009, we have recorded 50 crimes throughout Quedgeley, of which 15 were in the Kingsway.

- Yet again there was no serious recorded crime in Quedgeley this month. The worst offences have been burglaries to empty properties.
- There were 9 burglaries on the area this month.
- There were 14 criminal damages, ranging from throwing a wheelie bin into a window, to removing a slat from a wooden panel fence and snapping it.

Other Issues:

Towards the end of the year, I am to be joined by another officer in covering my current area, a reflection of how large it is becoming my boss said! PC Emma McDONALD, a capable and experienced officer, returns from maternity leave and we will be working together over the area. Quedgeley has seen an increase in the number of officers recently, replacing some of those injured or pregnant. This should start to show in the near future.

The pubwatch idea for Quedgeley and Hardwicke remains to the forefront of what I would like to do, however, I haven't had any time to work on it this month.

Panel meeting this Wednesday. All members of the panel have had two months to consult on what police priorities should be in the forthcoming months. I look forward to a productive meeting.
