

Report For Quedgeley Parish Council, 15th June 2009.

Figures for this report have been taken from Police Management Information System (MIS).

They are accurate as of Monday 15th June 2009, 1900hrs.

Over the course of April 2009, police were called to record disorder 53 times, 25 of which were in the Kingsway estate.

In May 2009, Police were called to Disorder incidents 50 times through the course of the month, 29 of which were on the Kingsway..

During April 2009, we have recorded 50 crimes throughout Quedgeley, of which 15 were in the Kingsway.

Over the course of May 2009, there were 63 crimes recorded, of which 25 were on the Kingsway estate. The number has been lifted with a significant number of theft from motor vehicles, and correspond almost identically to the release and capture of Quedgeley's biggest car thief.

- 12 burglaries
- 8 criminal damages
- 27 thefts
- 12 violent offences, including one GBH

So far, 5 of these offences have been detected, however, this number is expected to rise.

Other issues:

Some facts and figures learnt this month. There are approximately 13,500 people living on the Inspector neighbourhood Area covered by Quedgeley Police station. There have been 286 crimes reported since the start of the year across Quedgeley Parish.

There will be no Quedgeley and Hardwicke Pubwatch, as it doesn't have the support of the Inspector in charge of Licensing at Gloucester police station. Over the course of the month, I will be urging local licensee's to be using the present system, which they are obliged to do by their conditions.

We are looking to increase funding for various youth groups in the area over the coming months, and would welcome any suggestions you may have in relation to how this can be done.
